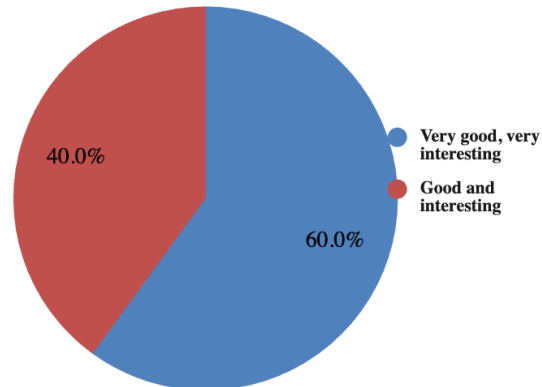


## THE STUDENTS FEEDBACK WHO STUDIED THE E-COURSE "URBAN LOGISTIC"

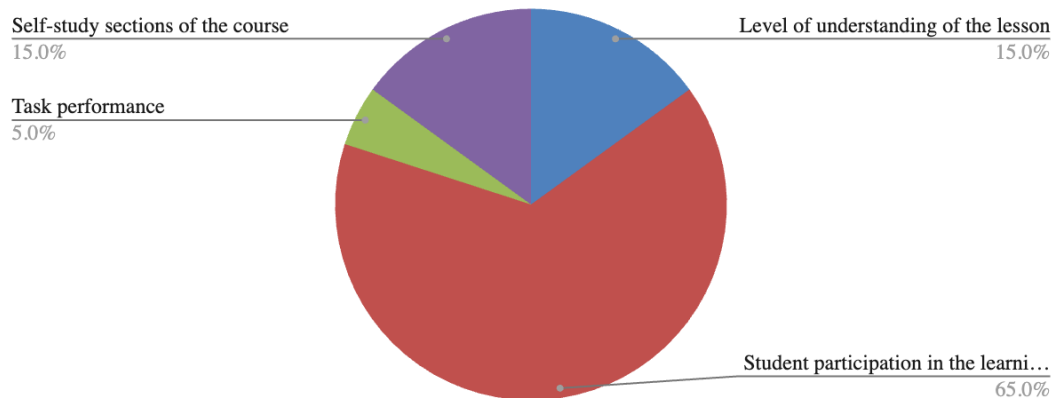
The aim of this questionnaire was to evaluate the quality, accessibility, content, format, teaching methods, and teacher's skills of the course and ask for suggestions for further improvement from the students who studied the e-courses developed under the URGENT project.

The survey consists of a total of 11 questions, and 24 students who studied the integrated course such as online and class room in the I semester of the 2022-2023 academic year participated in the survey after completing the course.

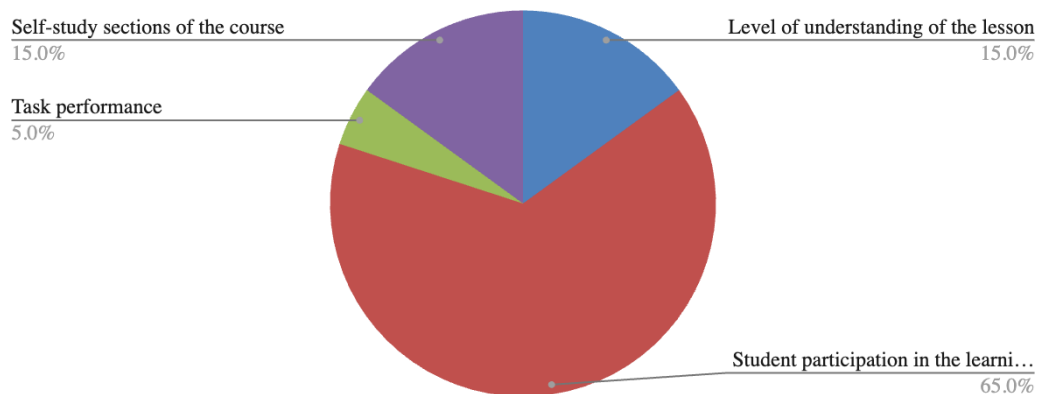
1. Your overall assessment of the course studied. Did you find the lesson interesting?



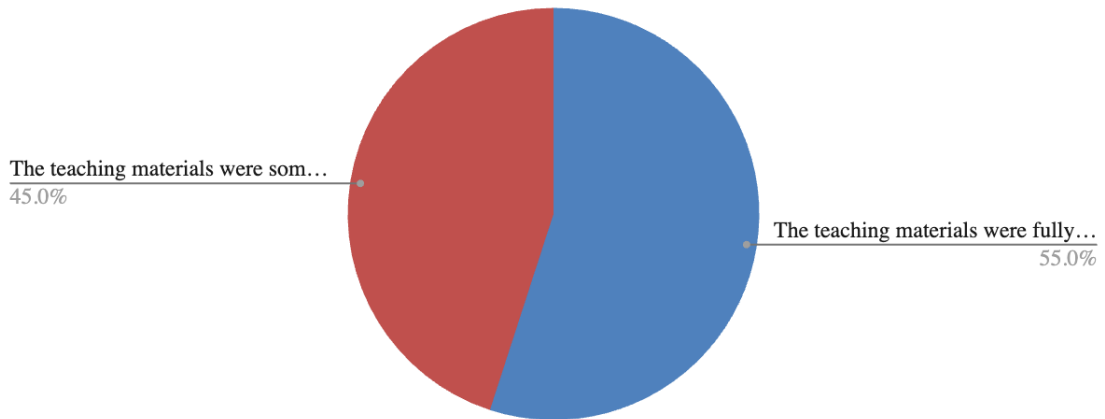
2. In your opinion, the effectiveness of the lesson has increased by ...



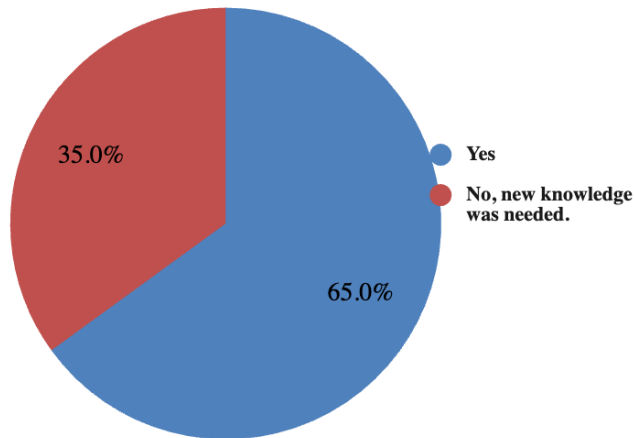
3. Which aspect of the course did you find most useful and interesting during the course?



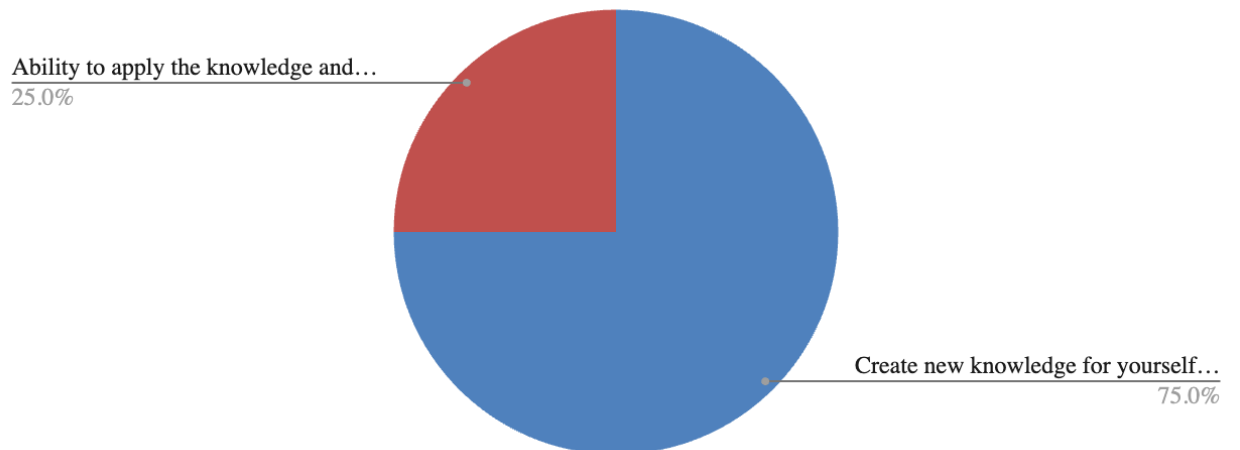
4. How do you rate the course material? Does it support the learning process?



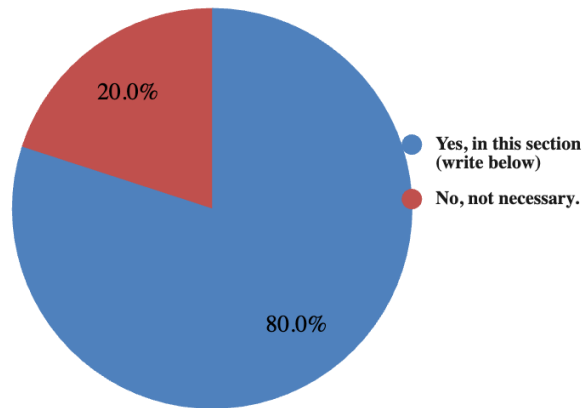
5. Was your personal knowledge level sufficient to understand the lesson?



6. What new knowledge and skills did you acquire as a result of studying this course (compared to other courses)?



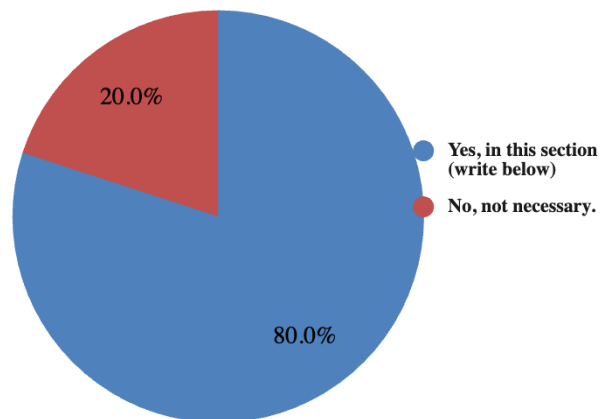
7. Do you think the course needs to be improved and in what areas?



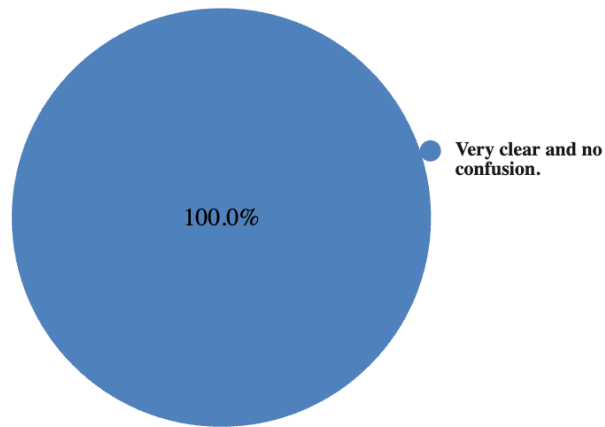

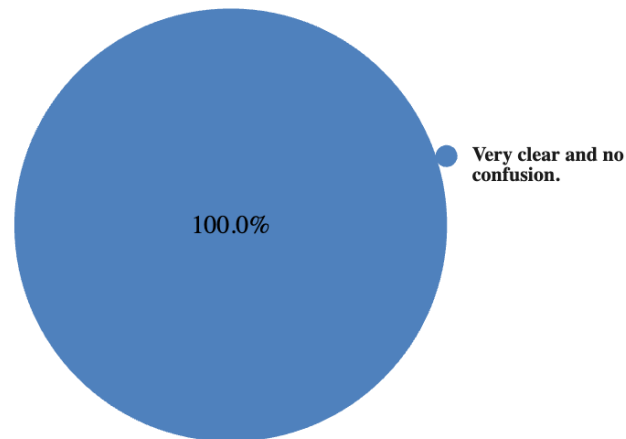
9. How do you generally rate the benefits of e-learning components when using a blended/e-learning model?

**Conclusion:**

- The course was very engaging and interesting for the students (100%), and in terms of the results of the course, it ensured student participation (65%), promoting individual participation and using blended learning methods (80%).
- The teaching materials of the course are fully consistent with the content of the course, and the learning process was evaluated as effective and fully consistent with the curriculum (95%).
- When studying the subject, new knowledge and information were obtained in connection with the contents of other subjects (75%), and the ability to use the knowledge and skills taught in the subject in practice was 25%.
- 80% of all students assessed that the content of the course needs to be improved.
- Using video lectures in blended or e-learning is very useful for self-study (95%) and participation in e-learning does not cause obvious confusion (100%).
