### Current research profile of the organization in relation to URGENT topics:

The research at the university is promoted at all levels. There are PhD scholars who are doing research on URGENT cross cutting themes. Research is also conducted every year by about 80 undergraduate students and many of them take topics related to URGENT cross cutting themes. produce theses research Besides this, many faculty members are also engaged in Minor Research Project and are conducting 1/2 year research that is fully funded by the university.

PhD program has 10 scholars enrolled. More recent enrollments can be supported with additional Guide/ Joint Supervision from EU. EU Partners can also become examiners to ones in penultimate stage. We look forward to signing MoUs with all partners and are particularly interested to do joint studios/ student exchange/ faculty exchange/ joint field work and explore areas for joint research with University of Catania as we belong to the same domain.

### Obstacles and barriers hampering the aspired developments

Our programs are relatively new, and we are adding new programs each year. The Urban Design course will start in July 2022, and we hope to start our master's in planning. B Arch program and PhD are ongoing programs. The success of these programs is dependent on market response. Starting new courses was a problem looking at the pandemic.
