Each partner page contains the list of courses created or revised under URGENT. For each of such courses you can find the following links or documents (some are still pending):

- Course syllabus developed according to the requirements of the European Higher Education Area, and on the uniform URGENT template; course posters presenting courses in a concise form; if available, also syllabi in accordance with national or institutional requirements; for some courses partners also offer video introductions;
- Links to course e-learning pages; normally the full access to e-learning pages require enrollment to the course; representatives of URGENT partner institutions are entitled to access any e-learning contents; please reach your institutional URGENT coordinator to enroll to a course belonging to another URGENT partner;
- Presentations of course -e-learning – such presentation provide a quick preview of all the available e-learning contents;
- Visuals and/or interactive materials for blended learning, such as video lectures; please observe that a full collection of video lectures developed under URGENT is also available from <https://urgent-project.net/en/php/page.php?s=208>;



- Other teaching learning materials, such as lecturer notes, course overviews, guidance to the materials developed under a course, etc.;
- Links to accreditation documents (according to national or institutional regulation; for some courses the accreditation may be pending);
- Course reviews by URGENT EU partners, as well as external and internal academic and non-academic organisations, including the representatives of potential employers; some reviews may be pending;
- Once all the courses will be completed by the first groups of enrolled students, the CLP will also contain quality assurance overviews summing up student evaluations.

On the page dedicated to URGENT non-degree training events you will typically find course description and detailed programs, links to course materials (including presentations sanctioned by copyright owners to open access), and summaries of evaluations (where relevant).
